Why You Should Take Our Course?

This is a dental implant training program designed for dental clinicians to be able to place dental implants and perform advanced implant surgery under close supervision on live-patients in Baja California.

This course is open to clinicians with or without previous exposure to implant dentistry and does not require prerequisites. Participants can receive up to 38 Continuing Education Units (CEUs) from the California Dental Board, AGD PACE and ADA CERP at the time of completion, together with a "Certificate of Completion" worthy of display.

GDIA offers three levels of Dental Implant Surgical Training -Fundamental, Intermediate, and Advanced. GDIA also offers the Soft Tissue Live-Patient Surgical Training Program in Baja California. This program focuses on soft tissue management rather than implant placement.

All levels will cover from diagnosis, treatment planning and live surgery. This course is limited to 10 doctors. With the guidance of instructors and volunteering GDIA mentors, we maintain a 2:1 ratio of participants to instructor. During the program, you will perform surgery on patients under the direction of top clinicians from our faculty members.

All patients and cases will be selected and pre-screened by GDIA faculty before the program.



This course is a 4-day program designed to cover basic didactics of multiple aspects of dental implant surgery and digital guided surgery. This course will allow clinicians to build fundamental knowledge of implant placement, diagnosis and treatment, basic surgical principles (such as suturing, incisions, and flap design), and operation on single and multiple implants on partially edentulous patients. After this course, you will be expected to understand the planning and surgical protocol for the use of surgical templates. You will know how to perform proper placement of dental implants through free-handed and computer guided surgery. You will perform live surgeries on patients in a group of two and one instructor will be supervising the entire surgery.


