

Course Descriptions

Guided bone regeneration (GBR) is a surgical technique used to regenerate bone in the areas of bone loss or where there is insufficient bone for an implant placement. This course is designed to provide participating doctors with a comprehensive understanding of the fundamentals of GBR including bone graft materials and membrane selection, as well as the different techniques for membrane fixation such as membrane tacks, sutures, and screws. The course will focus on membrane selection, including different types of membranes available and their properties as well as the factors that influence membrane selection. Participants will also learn about the different techniques for membrane fixations. This course will include hands-on sessions on pig jaws in which participants will have an opportunity to practice the techniques covered in the course.

Dr. Kevin Kim, DDS. FGDIA

Dr. Kevin Kim received his undergraduate degree in psychology from the University of California San Diego. He attended the University of Southern California to obtain his Doctorate of Dental Surgery.

Dr. Kim is a graduate of the Kois Center, has completed courses on advanced bone grafting at the Pikos Institute, took a nine-month implant training program at the Misch International Implant Institute, trained in the use of Puros block allograft, completed implant training at The Zimmer Institute, and completed an IV sedation course. All of the time he has spent learning new things and keeping up to date on current technology directly influences the care he is able to give his patients.


