### **Course Objective:**

Basic Implant Course is specifically designed for dentists who are new to dental implant placement. The first session will concentrate on basic surgical and implant therapy, with a focus on mastering the single-tooth implant. The course aims to provide dentists with a solid foundation in the knowledge and skills required to safely and effectively diagnose, plan, and place dental implants in their own offices.

### **DAY 1 (Friday, Dec. 6, 2024)**

- Evaluating patients: anatomy, medical assessment, site volume
- Understanding fundamentals of bone biology, wound healing, biomechanics
- Navigating implant console, motor, surgical kit, prosthetics
- · Planning and placing implants in correct location, angulation, depth via freehanded

### **DAY 2 (Saturday, Dec. 7, 2024)**

- Planning an intermediate case and deciding correct size, position
- Learning materials and methods of bone grafting and membranes
- Restoring implants with excellent cosmetic results
- Implementing excellent sterile technique
- Developing good clinical decisions and clear dialogue with patient


