Predictable success in immediate extraction and implant placement depends on two critical components: atraumatic tooth removal and precise osteotomy preparation to achieve primary implant stability. This course will provide a detailed, step-by-step approach to treatment planning, surgical methodology, and technical execution necessary to deliver reliable outcomes. Emphasis will be placed on accurate patient evaluation and matching case complexity to the clinician's skill level—building confidence for both surgeon and patient while consistently meeting functional and aesthetic expectations.



By the end of this course, participants should be able to:

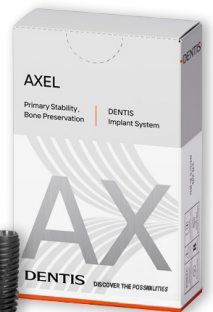
Evaluate Patient Candidacy: Identify appropriate clinical scenarios for immediate implant placement by matching case complexity with the practitioner's specific skill level and experience.

Execute Atraumatic Extractions: Perform minimally invasive tooth removal techniques designed to preserve the surrounding alveolar bone and soft tissue architecture.

Master Osteotomy Precision: Demonstrate the technical steps for precise osteotomy preparation to ensure optimal implant positioning and primary stability in extraction sockets.

Develop Comprehensive Treatment Plans: Formulate a step-by-step surgical and restorative protocol that addresses both functional requirements and aesthetic expectations.

Manage Clinical Risk: Implement a systematic methodology to minimize complications and deliver predictable, reliable outcomes for patients seeking expedited implant therapy.
